lava - A very hot liquid which comes out of a volcano. This turns into solid rock when it cools.

mermaid - A mythical creature that is half fish and half human.

ocean - A large amount of salt water between continents.

Plastic Pollution

Plastic causes lots of problems in the oceans. Animals can become tangled in the plastic injuring themselves. Lots of animals think the plastic is food and eat it. This can cause the animals to die. Plastic can stay in the ocean for thousands of years.



Underwater Volcanos

Volcanos can be on land or in the ocean. When they are under the ocean, the sea water can guickly turn the lava into solid rock. Over hundreds or thousands of years, the volcano grows taller and taller. Eventually the volcano may grow above the surface of the ocean. This creates a new island.
