

Year One

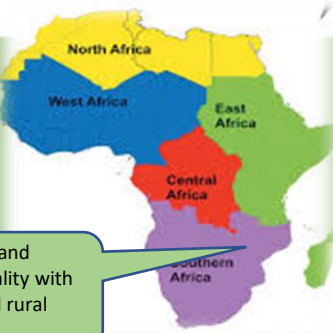
Locational and place knowledge

Year Two

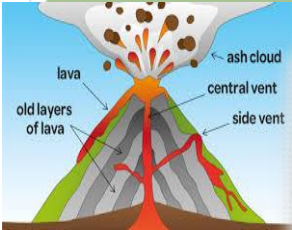
United Kingdom

Through the topics of Fire and Plague and The Stone Age children will learn about the United Kingdom, to include places, locations and key features.

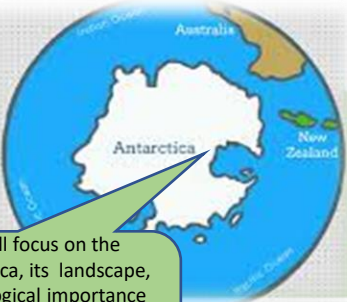


Year Four

Extreme Earth



Extreme Earth will focus on the continent of Antarctica, its landscape, climate and its ecological importance in the future sustainability of the Earth. It will also cover other naturally occurring events such as volcanoes..



Birmingham

Under the Sea

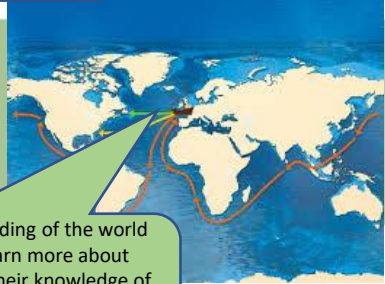


Children will learn about human and physical features, environmental issues and locational knowledge of the World's major oceans/seas.

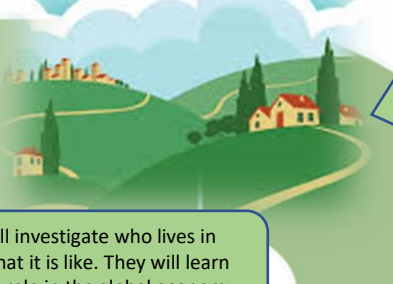
Year Five

World Exploration

Children will learn how our understanding of the world has changed over time. They will learn more about globalisation and trade and increase their knowledge of the diversity of the world in which they live. This will be done through a focus on Tudor exploration , Ancient Greece and Protest and Politics



Landscape & Settlement



Through the study of Ancient Greece they will learn about how landscape often determines where and why settlements are located
