<b>Learning Strengths</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Collaboration</li> <li>Initiative</li> <li>Originality</li> <li>Risk Tasking</li> </ul>
<b>Achievements</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Performing in a music concert</li> <li>Having a piece of topic work exhibited outside the headteacher's office</li> <li>Learn a musical instrument</li> <li>Showing excellent effort and commitment in taking roles in dramatic performances</li> <li>Taking part in choir club</li> <li>Taking part in an art club</li> <li>Taking part in a class assembly</li> <li>Short listed for an art competition</li> </ul>
<b>External Achievements</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Earning a new music grade certificate</li> <li>Winning an award in art competitions</li> <li>Performing to an audience</li> <li>Going to watch a performance (pantomime, theatres, production, concert)</li> <li>Visiting an art gallery or concert hall e.g. symphony hall or Birmingham's town hall.</li> <li>Learn to play a musical instrument outside of school</li> <li>Bake or decorate a cake</li> <li>Help prepare a meal (from scratch) for your family with adult supervision</li> <li>Take part in a dance, ballet, or drama lessons</li> <li>Bringing into school 2 quality pieces of artwork homework, which has not been set by the class teacher</li> <li>Designing, creating and sewing a puppet or knitting an item of clothing such as a scarf</li> <li>Create a short animation using an animation app on a computer tablet</li> <li>Record a short performance, poetry reading or reading of a chapter of a story with expression</li> </ul>
