







Have you requested support from school during this lockdown?


Did this support provide a resolution?




Do you have enough devices at home for your child/children (who attend our school) to access online learning?

How would you rate our school provision for providing learning to children during this lockdown?




Approximately, how many hours a day is your child doing school learning?


Do you feel that your child is getting the right amount of work?



What is going well with our remote learning provision/support? ⁵³ responses

How could we improve our remote learning provision further? ³⁹ responses

No Improvements required

- Can't think of anything/It doesn't need any improvement x13
- Not just saying this to be kind, but I really think you are giving everything you can and we greatly appreciate it.

More time to complete work/pace/amount of learning

- A little more time to do work
- As a family were struggling with the time given between each online lesson to complete the work. We always have to come back to the work later on in the day because we need to move onto the next live lesson. The work is doable however it takes a little longer to explain after the lesson and go through with my child. Sometimes we don't have enough hours in the day to complete every piece of work set.
- My child struggles with the pace and doesn't always feel confident to ask for help online.
- Less online time. 3 hours is too much for 5 year olds. Some paper-based work, recorded lessons that can be accessed at a later time, as the morning might not be convenient for parents to support their kids, whilst working from home.
- I personally would like to see my daughter doing more if possible

Submitting work online

- Be able to send work easier I can't do it on google classrooms and have had trouble with the email to the point miss Boyle had to email off her personal one to be able to respond to me hopefully I will now be able to access this as she helped me loads with getting the email correct
- Submit work for marking online
- Editing the worksheets has been quite difficult at times. I have personally had to spend an excessive amount of time downloading, updating and then learning the procedures necessary to to edit and return the work. I could not have expected my child to understand the many procedures involved. It is not simple. The procedures need to be simplified. Despite these initial hiccups, the provision this time compared with the first school closures last year is far better and my child's teacher has been very understanding when I have spoken to her.



<u>Feedback</u>

- Explaining lessons a bit more and what is required and when to log off until the next lesson, my child isn't always sure
- More feedback on the pieces of work submitted.
- The online work submitted has only been marked once so far so would be nice to see a few more comments as I find this massively encourages the children.

Lesson type/Structure/Challenge

- It would be nice to have some more creative art or science based activities to do that are away from the computer, as currently everything is screen based and she is complaining of sore eyes by the end of each day.
- Sometimes Charlie finds the work a little too easy and finishes it quickly.
- Maybe a one to one online with his teacher so he can focus a little more
- Maybe doing a topic live lesson
- Large part of the available time for online teaching should be used for active, communicative tasks and less for independent tasks.

Miscellaneous

- My daughter does say she misses having 1 1 discussion with her teacher about the work.
- Having him back in school
- Sort the technical issues with live lessons.
- Teacher work, extra work on areas which need improvement.
- Better access for remote learning and better connectivity.
