Dear Parents/Guardians,

You may be aware; your child has been taking part in Resilience 2 Resolve which is a 12-week programme designed to build the children's resilience, self-esteem, confidence, and to address youth violence within Birmingham. As the programme is coming to an end, Birmingham Youth Service (BYS) would like to put on a taster session at The Factory Young People's Centre in Longbridge as part of our exit strategy for the children.

The session will act as an introduction to the BYS where the children will take part in taster activities to enhance their understanding of what we offer as a service, to meet the team and become familiar with the building. These activities may include cake decorating, games in the sports hall and problem-solving activities.

BYS feel this is a great opportunity for the children as they soon transition into secondary school, and we would like to continue to support them throughout their adolescence. The session will run afterschool and we will provide a coach for the children to be transported straight after school at no cost to you or the school. You will however need to pick your child up from The Factory Young People's Centre at 5:40pm. Please note that the whole trip/visit will be supervised by staff from BYS and that Colmers Farm staff will not be involved in this visit.

If you would like your child to take part in this experience, please see complete the consent form and bring back to school at your earliest convenience as children without consent will be unable to attend.
