- The Nest team (Miss Evans and Miss Storer) working with key children completing 'check-ins' and interventions;
- Liaising with Rubery Community Swap Shop to provide uniform for families;
- Leadership being accessible and all of us being eager to hear about the good things we are doing as a school and also to share ideas about how we can improve further;
- Accompanying parents to medical appointments where a school perspective is required;
- Active SENDCo and Pastoral Leads meeting with parents as needed.
