Year 4: Gurdwara Visit

As part of our Religious Education topic about Sikhism, we will be taking the Year 4 children to the Guru Nanak Gurdwara in April 2026. Each class will go on a separate day – see details below:

- **Wednesday 15th April** **4J**
- **Thursday 16th April** **4B**

The children will travel via our school minibuses to the Gurdwara and will arrive at approximately 10:30am. The children will then have a tour of the Gurdwara before taking part in a taster session of some traditional blessed food called Langar. **Children do not have to take part in the taster session.**

The children will travel back to school and will have their lunch as usual but at the later time of 1pm.

Heads must be covered prior to entry to the Gurdwara with a scarf/shawl or bandana. A hood/ hat/cap is **NOT** acceptable and is found to be disrespectful in a place of worship. If you do not have a head covering, children will be provided with one by the school or by the Gurdwara.

We are asking for a contribution of £2 per child towards this visit which can be paid via Arbor.
