We are excited to share that we will be launching a whole school “**Right to Play Campaign**” during the Summer Term, linked to **Soccer Aid 2026**.

## What is Soccer Aid?

Soccer Aid is a national charity event that brings together football and fundraising to support UNICEF. The money raised helps children around the world access their basic rights, including the **right to play (Article 31)** and the **right to health (Article 24)**. With football being a major focus this term, we felt it was a fantastic opportunity to combine this excitement with an important message about children’s rights and global equality.

## Our “Right to Play” Campaign

From **Monday 8th June to Friday 26th June 2026**, pupils across the school will take part in a range of activities designed to raise awareness of children’s rights and support UNICEF’s work.

These will include:

- A launch assembly for Years 5 and 6
- Lunchtime football tournaments for Upper Key Stage 2
- A Soccer Aid club for Years 3 and 4
- PE-based obstacle and activity sessions for Key Stage 1
- Classroom discussions linking sport to children’s rights and global issues
