- Entering an external competition e.g. poetry, story writing etc
- · Visiting and joining a local library
- Visiting a museum- Birmingham Art Gallery or a historical site (cathedral/old church).
- Carry out a science project- There are lots of ideas online- This could be around your new science unit.



- Try a new sport that you have not tried before e.g. tennis, badminton, chess
- Helping you parents with the gardening on at least 3 occasions.
- Visit a nature sire- Lickey Hills, Kingsbury Water Park, Wyre Forest etc.
- · Help to prepare and cook a healthy meal.




- Designing, creating, and sewing a puppet or knitting an item of clothing such as a scarf

- Create a SAGE or British Values video to share with KS2.
