#### Dear Parents,

Welcome to the penultimate newsletter of this term. I hope that you have had a good week.

We have been marking Human Rights Day this week with a series of physical activities carried out by each year group such as running or walking a set distance. Human rights are something that we often take for granted in this country, however it is important to remember that many of these rights are not accessible in many countries across the world.

This week, Year 2 have been taking their phonics screening check. This has replaced the phonics check that the children should have taken at the end of Year 1, but which was cancelled due to lockdown. The children have done really well with this, particularly considering how much schooling these children have missed over the last year. With 74% of children reaching the threshold for this. Well done Year 2! Your child's teacher will soon be letting you know how they got on. For children who did not reach the threshold required, they will have another chance to take the phonics screening check at the end of year 2.

On Friday, we had our second ever set of Governors' Award Assemblies (after the first set last December). These assemblies were supposed to take place termly, but Coronavirus unfortunately prevented us from doing this last year. For the assemblies today we were joined on Microsoft Teams by two of our Governors – Our chair of Governors Mrs Wadley and our staff Governor Mrs Corbett.
