This newsletter contains information about your child's learning in maths, English and topic. If you have any questions we are here to help.

The children will be undertaking their phonics screening test after the May half term holiday. Please read with your children as much as possible over the next few weeks to help with their fluency and confidence with reading. We are sure they will do their best.

## English

- Apply phonic knowledge and skills as the route to decode words
- Respond with the correct sound to graphemes (letters or groups of letters)
- Naming the letters of the alphabet in order
- Re-reading what they have written to make sure it makes sense
- Use the prefix un-
- Use the suffixes -ing, -ed, -er and -est where no change is needed to the root word.

Children change their Read, Write,

#### Homework

Homework is sent out every Friday. Please ensure homework is completed and handed in the following week. Also, continue to encourage your child to practice their counting and number bonds, as well as using their phonics.

- Identify and represent numbers to 100 using objects and pictorial representations including the number line, and use the language of: equal to, more than, less than (fewer), most, least.
- Money
