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### **English**

We will continue to embed the following skills:

- To use the conjunctions: and, but, so and because, to vary sentences.
- To practice reading familiar texts to build fluency.
- To develop comprehension skills by answering retrieval questions finding the answer in the text.

We will be writing the following text types:
