- To develop comprehension skills by answering retrieval questions—finding the answer in the text.

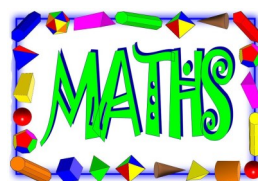
We will be writing the following text types:
