Water bottle

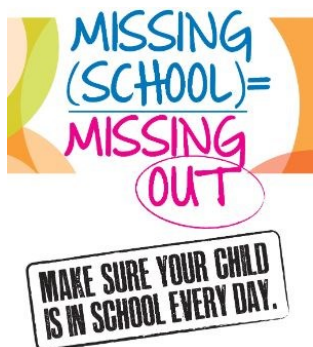
Please ensure your child brings a water bottle to school, with a clearly marked name label.
