Maths

- Recall multiplication and division facts for multiplication tables up to 12×12 .
- Use place value to order and compare decimals.
- Use place value and decimals to round amounts to the nearest pound.
- Use knowledge of money to solve problems.
- Convert units of measure to smaller and larger units.
- To measure perimeter in cm and mm.

- Use paragraphs to organise ideas.
- Use capital letters, full stops, question marks, exclamation marks, commas for lists.
- Produce writing to entertain the reader.
- Use powerful language to persuade.
- Spell words correctly from the year 3/4 list.
- Use correctly punctuated speech in their writing.
