<u>Maths</u>

Read and write numbers to at least 100 in numerals and in words.

Recognise the place value of each digit in a two-digit number (tens, ones).

Compare and order numbers from 0 up to 100; use <, > and = signs. Recall and use addition and subtraction facts to 20 fluently, and derive and use related facts up to 100.

Solve problems with addition and subtraction.

<u>English</u>

To use capital letters and full stops consistently, and other punctuation such as question marks. To retell and write stories with a beginning, middle and end. To use the conjunctions: and, but, so and because, to vary sentences. To practise reading familiar texts to build fluency.

To develop comprehension skills by answering retrieval questions finding the answer in the text.
