Maths

- Read and write numbers from 1 to 20 in numerals and words.
- Read, write and interpret mathematical statements involving addition (+), subtraction (-) and equals (=) signs.
- Add and subtract one-digit and two-digit numbers to 20, including 0.

English

- Apply phonic knowledge and skills as the route to decode words.
- Respond with the correct sound to graphemes (letters or groups of letters).
- Begin to form lower-case letters in the correct direction, starting and finishing in the right place.
- Saying out loud what they are going to write about.

Reading

Children will be bringing a phonic book and a reading for pleasure book home over the next few days. Children should be able to read their phonic book independently. Reading for pleasure books are for you and your child to enjoy together. Please record when your child has read using their book-marks.

QR codes

Children will be sent home with phonic QR codes. These codes can be scanned using a phone or device to access videos that reinforce the sounds the children have learned.

PE Kit

PE is every Wednesday. Please ensure that your child comes into school in a suitable PE kit every week.

Water Bottles

Please ensure your child brings a filled water bottle into school. Please remember that only water should be brought into school.
