Maths

- Recognise, find, name and write fractions.
- Know the number of minutes in an hour and the number of hours in a day.
- Compare and sequence intervals of time.
- Tell and write the time to five minutes, including quarter past/to the hour, and draw the hands on a clock face to show these times.
- Identify and describe the properties of 2D and 3D shapes, including the vertices, edges and faces.

PE Kit

PE is every Wednesday, please ensure that your child wears their PE kit to school.

English

- Apply phonic knowledge and skills as the route to decode words.
- Read aloud accurately books that are consistent with their developing phonic knowledge.
- Re-read these books to build up fluency and confidence in reading.
- Add prefixes and suffixes.
- Apply simple spelling rules.
- Write from memory simple sentences dictated by the teacher that include words using the GPCs and common exception words taught so far.

At Colmers Farm Primary School, reading is a high priority and plays an important role in our curriculum. Please aim to listen to your child read at least once a day and support them with their reading at home.
