

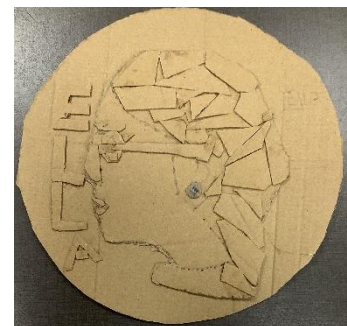
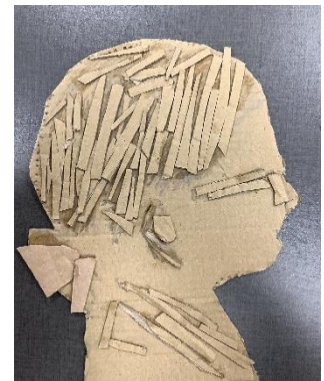
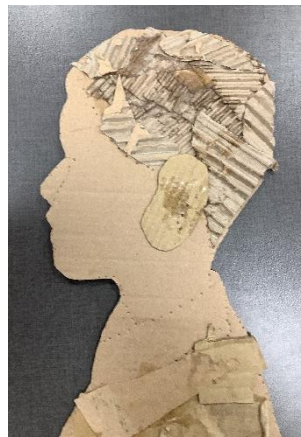
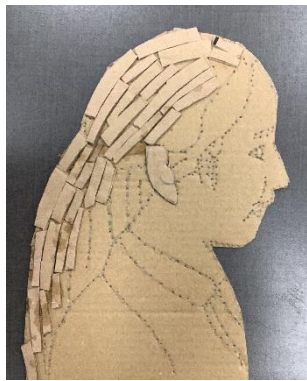
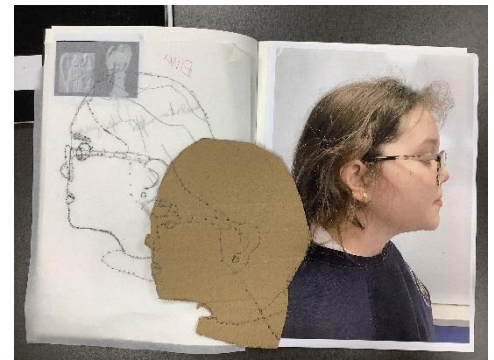
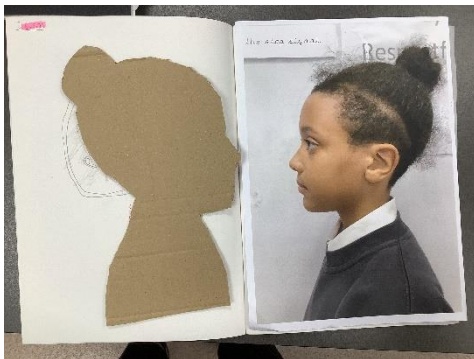
Year 4 Autumn Term Newsletter

Topic: The Romans

Year 4 have been learning about Roman sculptures and they have looked at examples of low-relief sculpture and sculpture-in-the-round. They have learnt how to create different tones with their pencil by applying different amounts of pressure. Year 4 looked at different examples of Roman coins and created their own low-relief coin using recycled cardboard.



Design Technology

Topic: The Romans



Year 4 have been focusing on structures and mechanisms in their design technology work this term. They were given a design brief to make a small model of a Roman Onager. They have measured, cut and joined pieces of wood and used junior hacksaws, bench hooks and lynx jointers to make their model of a Roman Onager. They have not quite finished their models yet, but they will be finished early in the Spring Term.
