Topic: WWII

Year 6 have learnt about the work of three different war artists: Henry Moore, Paul Nash and John Piper. They experimented with oil pastels in different ways including blending them, creating resist techniques by using an ink wash and oil pastels together and tried layering oil pastels. Year 6 chose their favourite artist from the three they had studied and created a composition based on either Coventry cathedral which was bombed during the Blitz in 1940 or a composition based on images from the current conflict between Russia and Ukraine.
