Maths

During this term we will:

- Read and write numbers to at least 100 in numerals and in words.
- Recognise the place value of each digit in a two-digit number (tens and ones).
- Compare and order numbers from 0 up to 100; use $>$, $<$ and $=$ signs.
- Recall and use addition and subtraction facts to 20 fluently.
- Solve problems using addition and subtraction.

English

During this term we will:

- Use capital letters and full stops consistently, and other punctuation, such as question marks.
- Retell and write stories with a beginning, middle and end.
- Use the conjunctions: and, but, so and because, to vary sentences.
- Practice reading familiar texts to build fluency.
- Develop comprehension skills by answering retrieval questions—finding the answer in the text.

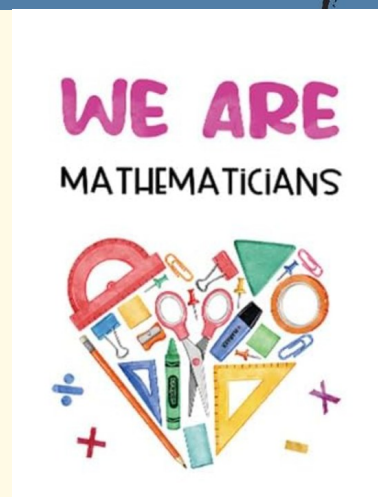
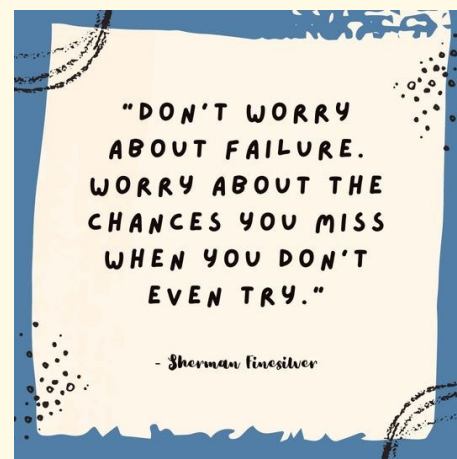
