Homework

Homework will be sent out on Friday and needs to be back in on Monday morning. The children will have a range of homework tasks over the half term. Each week the children will be given one homework piece to complete. Please make sure that homework tasks are completed in pencil and presented neatly.

Reading

It is really important that the children are reading at home every day. We have attached a book recommendation list to help you and your child select reading books that are appropriate for their age. Remember that reading will help them with their writing too!

Maths

- Count from 0 in multiples of 4, 8, 50 and 100.
- Work out if a given number is greater or less than 10 or 100.
- Recognize the place value of each digit in a 3-digit number (hundreds, tens, and ones)
- Solve number problems and practical problems involving these ideas.
- Add and subtract numbers with up to three digits, using formal written methods of columnar addition and subtraction

English

- Use paragraphs to organise ideas.
- Use capital letters, full stops, question marks, exclamation marks, commas for lists and apostrophes for contraction mostly correctly.
- Use formal language where appropriate
- Describe settings and characters.
- Spell most words correct from the year 3/4 list.
- Produce legible joined handwriting.
