Maths

- Count from 0 in multiples of 25, 100 and 1000.
- Estimating and rounding numbers to the nearest 10, 100 and 1000.
- Recognize the place value of each digit in a 4-digit number (thousands, hundreds, tens, and ones).
- Solve number problems and practical problems involving these ideas.
- Add and subtract numbers with up to four digits, using formal written methods of

English

- Use paragraphs to organise ideas.
- Use capital letters, full stops, question marks, exclamation marks, commas for lists and apostrophes for contraction mostly correctly.
- Produce writing to entertain the reader
- Describe settings and characters.
