<u>Maths</u>

This term we will be focusing on calculating with addition, subtraction, doubling and halving. We will also be looking at shape and pattern.

Please help your child at home by encouraging them to complete their maths and English homework each week. The homework will be something that they have covered in school that week and therefore they should be able to complete it at home. On the reverse of the maths homework sheet there will be a brief adult explanation to help you support your child at home.

English

This half term in English, we are learning about growing. We will be looking at the story 'Jack and the Beanstalk'. We will be growing our own beanstalks and other plants throughout the topic. We are also going to read the book 'The Hungry Caterpillar'. This will introduce the children to life cycles ready for when out 'Living Chicks' arrive.

Next half term, we will move onto looking at People. We are going to be looking at explorers and people who help us, so our stories and writing will be based around those topics.

If you have Jack and the Beanstalk at home, please read it with your child, if not there are some YouTube videos of people reading the story which would be great to watch

Forest School


